ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Primary responsibility to drive concrete mixer to work sites and discharge load.
- Delivers concrete as customer specifies, after determining customer's requests are safe and possible.
- Communicates truck/job status to dispatch.
- Maintains appearance of truck, proper air pressure in tires, proper fluid levels, oil, hydraulic, coolant and fuel.
- Performs minor repairs to truck as needed.
- Performs pre- and post-trip inspections to ensure safe operation of truck and mixer.
- Ensures that safety, compliance, environmental and DOT requirements are followed at all times.
- Driving Ready Mix truck, checking loads, washing mixer top to bottom, delivering concrete to various job sites, loading and dumping truck
- Completes all paperwork that may be necessary; assist with plant work as required by plant management.
- Issues or obtains customer signature on invoices for pickup or delivery.
- Records delivery and inventory information on daily invoices.
